

Excerpts from the "Agreement on the procedure for movement by individuals of goods for personal use through the customs border of the customs Union and customs operations connected with their release" (Annex 3):

Goods for personal use, with the exception of vehicles, imported into the customs territory of the customs Union in the accompanied and unaccompanied baggage with exemption from customs payments.

**THE LIST OF GOODS SUBJECT TO
DECLARATION IN WRITING THE IMPORTATION INTO THE CUSTOMS TERRITORY OF THE
CUSTOMS UNION AND (OR) EXPORT FROM THIS TERRITORY**

1. Goods for personal use transported in any way, including temporarily imported, the cost and (or) the number of which exceed the standards movement of such goods with exemption from customs payments.
2. Goods for personal use transported in unaccompanied baggage or delivered by carrier in the individual.
3. Goods for personal use transported in any way in respect of which bans and restrictions, except for measures of non-tariff and technical regulation.
4. Cash and (or) monetary instruments transported by individuals across the customs border in the cases established by the customs legislation of the customs Union.
5. Goods for personal use imported in accompanied baggage, if moving the physical person has the unaccompanied baggage.
6. Goods for personal use, specified in paragraphs 3 to 10 of section 1 of Annex 3 of the Agreement.

7. One-time import by an individual of cash and (or) traveler's checks in the total amount exceeding the equivalent of 10 thousand U.S. dollars.
8. The of import physical entity of monetary instruments, excluding traveler's checks, is subject to customs Declaration in writing.
9. Exported physical person of cash and (or) traveler's checks in the total amount exceeding the equivalent of 10 thousand USD, exported cash and (or) travel checks are subject to customs Declaration in writing.
10. The export of a natural person of monetary instruments, excluding traveler's checks, is subject to customs Declaration in writing.
11. Precious metals (gold, silver, platinum and metals of platinum group - palladium, iridium, rhodium, ruthenium and osmium) in any condition and form:
 - temporarily imported;
 - exported (except for temporarily exported jewelry including insets of precious stones).
12. Precious stones: imported temporarily, exported emeralds, rubies, sapphires and alexandrite, natural pearls in raw (natural) and processed kind, unique amber formations, diamonds, imported natural diamonds.
13. Cultural values.
14. Exported state awards of the Russian Federation.
15. Animals and plants under threat of disappearance, their parts, derivatives and derived products.
16. Weapons (devices and the subjects structurally intended for defeat of live or other target, giving signals), basic parts of firearms (barrel, bolt, drum, frame, receiver), cartridges (the device intended for the shot from the weapon, uniting in one with the liner means of initiation, with a propelling charge and throwing equipment), the components of ammunition (shells encapsulated, capsule, powder).
17. Imported alcoholic drinks and beer in the quantity exceeding 3 liters per one person over 18 years of age.
18. Imported tobacco products in quantities exceeding 200 cigarettes or 50 cigars or 250 grams of tobacco or specified products in assortment with the total weight exceeding 250 grams per one person over 18 years of age.
19. Narcotic drugs, psychotropic substances and their precursors.
20. Drastic and poisonous substances.
21. High-frequency appliances and radio electronics, except terminal equipment.
22. Special technical means intended for secret obtaining of information.
23. Outward material objects, containing information constituting a state secret.
24. Nuclear materials, equipment, special non-nuclear materials and appropriate technologies.
25. Radioactive isotopes, radioactive substances and products on their basis.
26. Exported raw materials, materials, equipment, scientific-technical information, results of intellectual activities that can be used to create weapons of mass destruction, their delivery vehicles, other armaments and military equipment.
27. Imported chemicals which can be used to create chemical weapons.
28. The military products.
29. Vehicle.
30. The goods transported in unaccompanied baggage.
31. Goods sent to natural persons for personal use, with the exception of goods sent by international mail.
32. Exported and imported by individuals caviar of sturgeon fish species in an amount of not more than 250 grams per person, regardless of age, are carried out without the export permit and import

permit issued by the administrative authority and the license of the Ministry of industry and trade of the Russian Federation.

33. Other goods specified by the customs legislation of the customs Union.

A natural person is in the right in his desire to produce a Declaration of goods for personal use, not subject to customs Declaration in writing using the passenger customs Declaration.

More detailed information is contained in the Extract from the agreement between the Government of the Russian Federation, the Government of the Republic of Belarus and the Government of the Republic of Kazakhstan dated 18 June 2010 "On the procedure for movement by individuals of goods for personal use through the customs border of the customs Union and customs operations connected with their release" (Attached).

Excerpts from the "Agreement on the procedure for movement by individuals of goods for personal use through the customs border of the customs Union and customs operations connected with their release"

**The list of goods for personal use
prohibited to import into the customs territory of the customs Union
and (or) export from this territory**

1	While moving across the customs border by any means:
1.1	information on print, audiovisual and other media, prohibited for importation into the customs territory of the customs Union, export from customs territory of the customs Union and transit on customs territory of the customs Union;
1.2	service and civilian weapons, its main parts and ammunition prohibited for importation into the customs territory of the customs Union, export from customs territory of the customs Union and transit on customs territory of the customs Union;
1.3	hazardous wastes prohibited for import and (or) limited to moving through customs border at import and (or) export;
1.4	special technical means intended for secret receipt of information, import of which into the customs territory of the customs Union and export from customs territory of the customs Union is restricted;
1.5	poisonous substances are not precursors of narcotic drugs and psychotropic substances, limited to moving through customs border;
1.6	narcotic drugs, psychotropic substances and their precursors, except for limited quantities of narcotic drugs and psychotropic substances in the form of medicines for personal use on medical indications in the presence of corresponding documents and also precursors in the volumes defined by the legislation of a member state of the customs Union
1.7	bodies and (or) human tissue, blood and its components limited to moving through customs border at import and (or) export;
2	While exporting in any way:
2.1	waste and scrap of ferrous and nonferrous metals included in the list of goods under export and (or) import of which quantitative restrictions;
2.2	raw precious metals, scrap and wastes of precious metals, ores and concentrates of precious

	metals and commodities containing precious metals, which are exported from the customs territory of the customs Union is restricted;
2.3	mineral raw materials (natural raw stones) limited to moving through customs border at export;
2.4	information on mineral resources, limited to moving through customs border at export;
2.5	wild medicinal raw materials (plants, parts of plants, seeds, fruits) limited to moving through customs border when exporting in excess of three instances of one type of such goods;
2.6	wild living animals and some wild plants limited to moving through customs border at export (with the exception of hunting and fishing trophies), in the quantity exceeding three copies of one type of such goods;
3	While importing in any way:
3.1	ozone depleting substances prohibited from being imported into the customs territory of the customs Union;
3.2	of plant protection products prohibited to import into the customs territory of the customs Union subject to annexes A and b of the Stockholm Convention on persistent organic pollutants, signed in Stockholm on 22 may 2001;
3.3	tools for extraction (catch) of aquatic biological resources prohibited from being imported into the customs territory of the customs Union;
3.4	ethyl alcohol and alcoholic products, totaling more than 5 liters per one person over 18 years of age;
3.5	more than 200 cigarettes or 50 cigars or 250 grams of tobacco or specified products in a set with a total weight exceeding 250 grams per one person over 18 years of age.
4	In international mail (in addition to items 1-3 of this section):
4.1	alcohol products, ethyl alcohol, beer;
4.2	any types of tobacco goods and Smoking mixtures;
4.3	all types of firearms (their parts), ammunition for them (their parts) constructively similar to civil and service weapons products;
4.4	radioactive materials;
4.5	cultural values;
4.6	Perishable goods;
4.7	live animals, except bees, leeches, silkworms;
4.8	plants in any form or condition, plant seeds;
4.9	precious stones in any form and condition, natural diamonds, except jewelry;
4.10	narcotic drugs, psychotropic substances and their precursors, including in the form of medicines;
4.11	ozone-depleting substances;
4.12	other goods forbidden to transfer in accordance with acts of the universal postal Union and customs legislation of the customs Union.
