## Warm Notice

The Carrier and its agents have fully discharged their obligation to advise me of all risks associated with this air transportation. Through such advisories, I have gained comprehensive understanding of these risks. Having considered all potential consequences, I nevertheless elect to proceed with the planned journey on the specified flight. For any issues arising during transport including but not limited to those caused by the inherent packaging or preservation of the human organs carried by myself, flight diversions, returns, or alternate landings due to force majeure events (e.g. weather, air traffic control, military activities, public security incidents, or other uncontrollable circumstances). I hereby agree to assume full and sole responsibility for all consequences. I expressly waive any right to initiate legal proceedings or assert claims for compensation against the Carrier or its agents in connection with such issues. I acknowledge with gratitude the assistance rendered by the Carrier and its agents.

On the passenger's application for taking the flight, the herein agreement is made based on the principle of fairness and honesty through consultation for the safety of the passenger:

### I Carrier's Transport Regulations

#### i Mode of Transport

Human organs must only be transported as cabin baggage (hand-carry or Cabin seat baggage) under the transporting passenger's custody throughout the journey.

#### ii Requirements of Package

1. Use professional transport containers that provide effective thermal insulation, shock resistance, portability, and airtight sealing (preventing odor leakage and liquid seepage).

2. The container's exterior must be non-disruptive to other passengers and prevent organ damage from in-flight cabin pressure variations or turbulence.

3. A dedicated label for human organ transport must be prominently displayed on the container's exterior.

#### iii Requirements of Documents

1. Confirmation of Organ Reception in Transplantation Center ( Original and Copy ) .

① Must specify the transported organ's legal source, intended use, contact person's name, phone number, etc.

② The document's validity must be authenticated.

2. An official letter of authorization from the transporting passenger's organization must include: Passenger's full name, Travel Documents Number, Authorizing organization, description of carried organs (type/preservation method), Security clearance requirements, date of issuance and bear the organization's official raised seal.

3. The Agreement for Human Organ Transportation, duly read and signed by the passenger.

### II Agreement Effectiveness and Termination

This Agreement shall come into effect upon execution by both parties (or their duly authorized representatives). After passengers arrive to destination by the carrier, the agreement terminates. Before the agreement takes effect to termination, if any side cannot carry out the agreement due to force majeure, the one should inform the other side the reason why it is unable to perform or not completely perform, and provide verified proof. Allowing to extension of performance, part of the performance or not to perform the agreement after consultation by both sides, and not assume responsibility for breach of contract.

### III Dispute Resolution

If there is a dispute between the two sides on this Agreement, both sides should negotiate friendly on the basis of understanding and accommodation. If the negotiation fails, the people's court at the place where the carrier is located shall be resolved.

### IV Other Conventions

i Hematopoietic stem cells, blood (including serum, plasma, blood products, etc.), cornea and other human organs or tissues carried by passengers shall be filled in and used according to the template of this agreement.

ii The agreement is in quadruplicate. Carrier's handling units hold one copy (totally in three copies), and passenger hold one copy.

iii Passenger carries \_\_\_\_\_ (for example: human organs or packaging requirements, etc.) not comply with the relevant regulations. The Passenger shall assume sole and absolute responsibility for all risks associated with such transportation. The Carrier shall have no liability whatsoever for any damage to the human organs arising therefrom during transportation.
